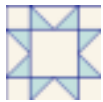

Either mail or email a copy of the entry form to Sharon Kubich in advance. Sharon will prepare and print the quilt information to be displayed with the quilts at the fair.

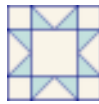

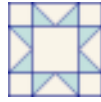
A card was sent to Tom Planer (Audrey’s husband) after his lung surgery. We all hope he is doing well.

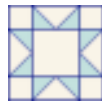
