Calling All Quilters, Embroiderers and Needle Artists:

To celebrate the 80th Anniversary of the Warren County Farmer's Fair, the Evening Star Quilter's Guild and the Tapestry Fiber Arts Group of Warren County, New Jersey, are co-sponsoring a Free Style Sun-Bonnet Sue Open Block Challenge.

This challenge will consist of a 10.5 inch square block featuring Sun-Bonnet Sue (or Overall Sam for any Man Quilter so inclined).

The block can be designed in the traditional appliqué format, or in red-work, embroidered, be-dazzled, beaded, wool felted, chenille, or in any combination of techniques. Be creative!

Each block must be a 10.5 inch square on a neutral background with Sun-Bonnet Sue as the main feature. Please sign your block. An historical record of all participants will be included.

Prizes will be awarded to the top three block entries.

Our goal is to have as many blocks as possible in order to piece a quilt during the Fair. The quilt will then be archived locally.
